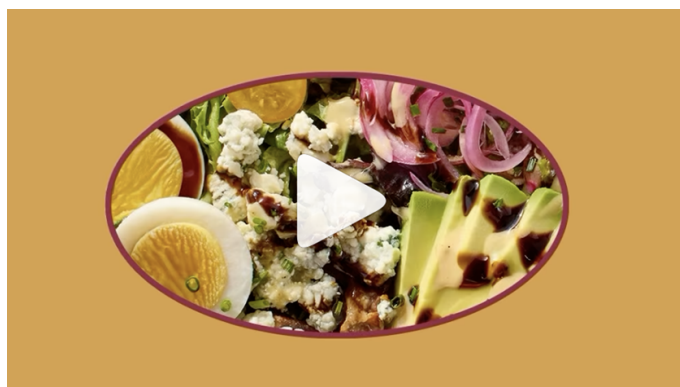

Crew

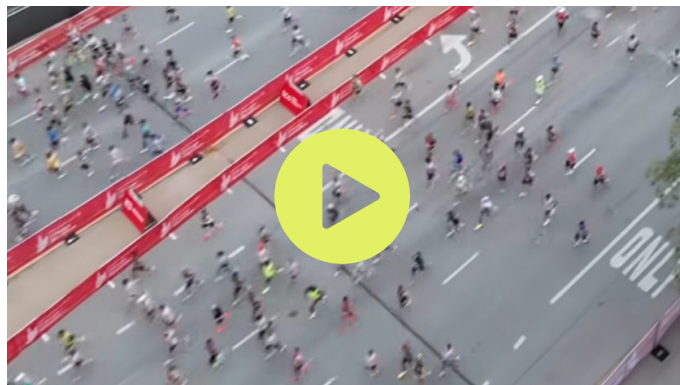
